OPEN FORUM

Hairless Disease

Jon Bernarski spoke on the testing the US Belted Galloway Society is doing on this genetic disease. Patches of up to 2 foot in diameter can be found on the cattle with this condition. They have taken samples of over 300 animals to date. They hope to have further information in the next 18 months to 2 years. Vic Eggleston would be the best person to contact for more information.

Facebook

Caroline McMillan spoke on the use of Facebook as a promotional medium. It is very interactive, instant and attractive to younger members. Suggested that any Associations who have a Facebook page to link to others.

Technical Expertise

Greg Stuart asked if anyone know of a person who could interpret the information which is being gathered by a number of Associations on the health aspects of the Galloway Beef.

Marketing

Helene Keller (Assisted by Kalu von Hollen) spoke on the success of Marcus Detweller marketing of Galloway beef. He has set up a Meat Stall at Zurich Train Station one day a week. It has proven to be so successful that he now requires 70 steers a year to sell at the station. His major problem is that the average herd in Switzerland is 6 cows.

Why has the Galloway lost its place in the beef industry?

Barry McAlley asked if we need to analyse why the Galloway has lost its place in the beef industry. We need to understand why we now find ourselves in the position where we have to promote the breed. After the successes in the past in various trials, etc when Galloways were an accepted breed – to now where we have to promote the breed. What has been the cause of this change? We need to encourage Galloways to be used in commercial herds to get the numbers to increase.

Mal Cock agreed that the breed needs to be promoted for commercial purposes. If we isolate the breed with pure-breeding we will need the assistance of the Rare Breed Association.

High Altitude Sickness

Patricia Pruitt asked what information was available on this condition. Harley Blegen advised that this condition which mainly affects male calves has been known to result in loss of 80 - 90% of the male calves. Galloways have been tested with very positive results. However they are faced with another problem in that the organisations doing the tests are being financed by larger breed associations and therefore have not released the results of the tests which may promote Galloways over these other breeds.

Brindle Colour

Harmut Kindle showed a photograph of a Galloway bull which was red in colour with black strips. This Brindle colour pattern was the result of breeding red on red. There followed much discussion on the attributes of White Galloways and Riggits.
